THE REFRACTION FEE IS \$50.00

Refraction testing is used to determine the eyes' ability to achieve optimal vision and is an important part of an eye exam. When considering surgery, this information is used to determine if the vision meets medically necessary requirements for surgery coverage. In other medical cases it determines the course of treatment moving forward and, in some cases, it simply determines if vision can be corrected.

Unfortunately, Medicare and most insurance plans do not cover this refraction test. You may choose to pay this fee now, or when you check in for your exam.
